## Ways the AUUC Supports Ukraine

Throughout the AUUC's more than 100-year history, we have maintained connections with Ukraine and our Ukrainian heritage, supporting the country and its people in many ways. We will continue to support the Ukrainian people in whatever ways we can. As one of the first Canadian organizations to formally acknowledge and congratulate Ukraine on its Declaration of Independence in 1991, Ukraine's continued well-being is and will always be of great importance to us.

Over the years, our organization has participated in various humanitarian initiatives to help Ukrainian citizens and families. Some of these initiatives include:

- sending financial support to help cancer patients following the Chernobyl disaster
- helping support children orphaned by the 2014 conflict in Donbas
- welcoming students to Canada who lost parents during the Maidan uprising

Since 2022 our branches have worked both independently and within the broader Ukrainian community on fundraising events for Ukraine. Our cultural groups have performed at countless fundraisers in support of Ukraine both at AUUC sponsored events and those sponsored by other organizations.

- raising and donating tens of thousands of dollars to medical and humanitarian aid to Ukraine.
- sending much needed medications to hospitals,
- helping finance transportation of supplies needed throughout the country,
- sending heating supplies during losses of fuel and electricity
- supporting children's mental health treatments

For those Ukrainians displaced by the war who have come to Canada, the AUUC has helped by

- providing information on where and how to access support,
- offered cultural groups access to our facilities for them to continue growing their Ukrainian culture,
- hosted events by groups that provide support to the immigrant community.

We will continue to offer these supports to the Ukrainian community both in Ukraine and in Canada throughout the current conflict and will stand alongside all who are affected by the war once peace arrives and rebuilding can begin.
